REQUIREMENT 4

b) Sew a miniature kilt (doll size), or equivalent, using tartan cloth.	
c) Create a standing cardboard or card-stock paper doll man in highland dress. Glue/ fasten a piece of tartan fabric onto your model person or create one that can be put on and removed at will. You may either draw or cut out paper kilt accessory items (waistcoat, sporran, etc.).
