

BIBLE QUIZZ PROGRAM

OBJECTIVES:

1. To arouse a new interest in the study of the Scriptures and to motivate the individual young person to follow a personal daily devotional study plan, setting aside a minimum of 30 minutes a day for the reading of his Bible and studying the life of Jesus.
2. To recognize those Pathfinders who in our clubs are faithful in their daily devotions.

WHO ARE ELIGIBLE:

1. Any Pathfinder (3) in good and regular standing.
2. Must wear uniform. (The only exception will be new club without uniforms as yet or new club members.)

SOURCE MATERIAL:

All questions will be based upon the King James Bible. The questions will come from the books of Matthew, Mark, Luke, John & Genesis. These questions will not try to stump the Pathfinders, but will be tough enough to challenge their knowledge of the above books. Encourage them to study.

PROCEDURE:

1. A Bible Quiz Team shall consist of three (3) Pathfinders, who meet the two eligibility qualifications listed above.
2. The quiz shall consist of 20 Questions directed to the teams by a quizmaster. Team members may discuss the questions asked among their own team members in a whisper. Above a whisper, the club will forfeit that answer.
3. Teams will be seated facing the audience and quiz-master.
4. Only those in uniform may participate unless yours is a new club or contestant is a new member.
5. Only three (3) or less Pathfinders per club.
6. A question answered correctly by team will add 5 game points.
7. Answers to questions will be written on paper and checked and scored after each question by the judges.
8. Twenty (20) seconds will be given to answer.
9. An easily read sign (CLUB NAME) is to be provided by each club on white poster board, 12'x20" with black letters.

10. A table will be provided for each group.
11. A staff member from each club will assist at another club's table.

SCORING:

A possibility of 100 game points can be obtained. Here is the award breakdown:

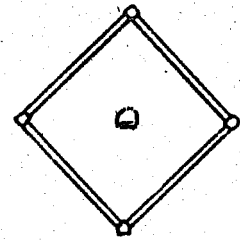

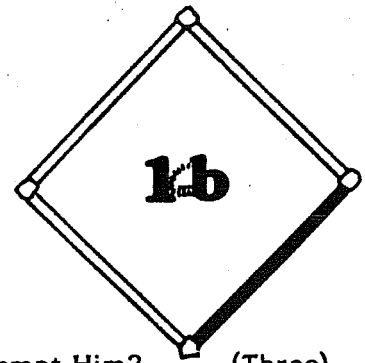
BIBLE BASEBALL



1. In advance of the program, the leader must prepare a list of questions on four different grade levels. The easy ones for first base hits (singles) the harder for second base hits (doubles), then for third base hits (triples,) and finally the more difficult questions (may be two or three part) are for the home runs.
2. Divide the group in two sections in any manner desired.
3. Place four chairs at the front of the room.
4. The first side at bat sends one player up who sits on the chair to the extreme right of the leader.
5. The first batter states that he desires one of the following "hits": A single, a double, a triple, or a home run question.
6. If he chooses a single and he answers correctly, he moves one seat to his right.
7. If he chooses a double and answers correctly, he moves two seats to his right.
8. If he chooses a triple and answers correctly, he moves three seats to his right.
9. If he chooses a home run question and answers correctly, he takes his seat at the end of his own line in the dugout.
10. As soon as he answers his one question, the next player goes to bat in the chair to the leader's extreme right.
11. The same number of vacant chairs is maintained between players at all times. (A double would knock a second baseman in for a run.)
12. Any question missed is an out for the team at bat.
13. Three outs or three questions missed places the other team at bat.
14. The team winning is the team with the largest number of runs.
15. Any number of innings may be played depending on the time allotted.

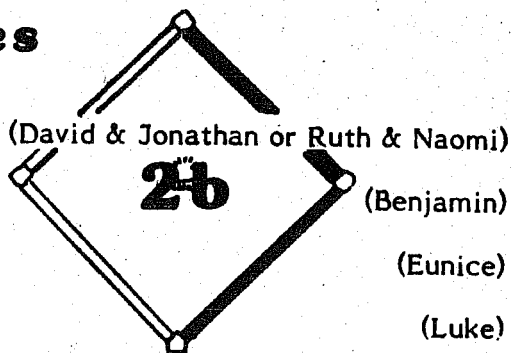
